F. Questions for Reflection

- i. If you visited the church in Ephesus for long enough to get a feel for it, how do you think you would describe it in your own words?
- ii. How does it make you feel to hear Jesus say the words, "I know your deeds"?
- iii. What do you think Jesus would commend about our church?
- iv. What does it mean to be an apostle? Are there still apostles today? Are there false teachers? How do we test people who claim to have some kind of spiritual authority?
- v. When we participate in the life of the church, do we do it because we feel like we *ought* to do it, because somebody *has* to do it, because somebody *asked* us to do it, or because of some other motivation? What does that motivation have to do with this letter?
- vi. What can we do to keep from forsaking "the love [we] had at first"? Does it have something to do with continuing to do the "things [we] did at first"? Practically speaking what does that look like?
- vii. Read 1 John 5:1-5 again. How does our love relate to our victory?
